SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

For the Stone Trough Trial

1. The Yorkshire Sports Car Club will organise a Club Sport Trial on Sunday 8th November 2009
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd., these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permit number: TBA
4. The event, is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, and The Northern Phoenix Trials Car Club and BTRDA members
5. All drivers must produce a club membership card.
6. The programme of the meeting will be, Scrutineering starts at 09.30am. Any competitor not signed on by 10.15am may be excluded. First car starts at 10:30am.
7. The only tyres permitted for the event will be either Vredestein Sprint+ or Firestone F 560
8. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 6 sections on private land. Details of the sections will be issued at signing on. The number of rounds will be related to the weather and the size of entry. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills.
9. All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations and with the National Trials Car Formula.
10. Classes as per club list.
11. Awards will be presented as follows, the Overall winner, classes A,B,C. Further awards at the discretion of the club. Competitors may only win one award.
12. The entry list opens on publication and closes on the **Wednesday** prior to the trial date. **The entry fee is £20.00.** All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

14. The maximum entry for the meeting is 60 and the minimum 10. Should the minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting. Entries will be accepted upon receipt. Entry fees will be refunded if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date.

16. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event.
17. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with section O.5.
18. Starting numbers will be allocated by ballot prior to the event.
19. Number cards that will be issued by the organisers will identify competitors.
20. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the MSA General Regulations.
21. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written except for the following, which is modified:
M.3.3.4 Start hills for each round will be notified at signing on and competitors will run in numerical order within each group throughout the event unless instructed otherwise by an official.
22. A brake & differential test will be made before the start of the event.
23. A minimum tyre pressure may be applied on the day. This will be determined by the weather/condition of the ground and will be at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. In the event of a minimum tyre pressure being applied, checks may be carried out to check compliance.
24. **No person may drive or be a passenger in a competing car on the site unless they have signed the clubs official indemnity form.
In the case of people who ignore this request, they may be disqualified and asked to leave the site.**
25. Cars may be double driven.
26. Toilet facilities will be available on site.
27. Important Notice.
As the Clerk of the Course is responsible for the safe running of the trial, No Marshall or Competitor may change a section without the permission of the Clerk of the Course.
28. Only intermediate poles provided by the club will be used. The clubs intermediate poles are White. These poles will only be used when there is a real danger of driving out of the section, (Four wheels out).
